

CHECKLIST FOR REUNION

1. If you have not done so, register for the reunion and answer the questions on-line regardless of whether you plan to attend the reunion. If you do not plan to attend (and we hope that number is few), enter 0 for the number attending.
2. Complete the Registration Form and the T-Shirt order form (if you want a t-shirt) & mail them to the address on the form. We need these forms by the end of the month so we can:
 - a. Know the head counts for each event (Friday night, Saturday morning Memorial Service & Saturday night) to assure that we have enough food;
 - b. Can order the T-shirts and mail them to those who want them mailed;
 - c. Make use of your profiles and answers to the questions to prepare the reunion booklet.
3. If you need motel reservations, we suggest that you make them at the Hampton Inn. They have provided us with a good rate that includes free breakfast and other amenities as well as a hospitality room. They have also set up a web page dedicated to us that we can use to reserve rooms. A link to that site is provided on our Home Page. Click on the Hampton Inn logo for access.
4. Call old friends and acquaintances to rev up your enthusiasm & to encourage those who have not registered to do so. Also, by making these calls, you may be in contact with some classmates that we have not been able to locate.
5. Also, enter memories on your profile. You may think you don't remember much. You are wrong. I know a lot of you can recount memories for I've heard you, but you have not entered them on your profile. Take time to think about your childhood & school years, the memories will come back.
