YMCA Jammed On Opening Day

More than 2,000 boys, girls, and adults streamed into the Gaston County YMCA Saturday.

The new facility has lobby and offices on the front side ground floor. The swimming pool, gymnasium, and health club, with showers and locker rooms, are in the basement.

"It was a full day—a strenuous day for our staff," said "Y" Secretary J. D. Hicks.

Hicks said the "Y" is open from 9 a. m. to 9 p. m. "although we haven't set any definite schedule."

He said he is trying to plan the schedule to avoid overcrowding. School children (up to 15) are not supposed to come on weekdays after 7 p. m. except in company with parents.

Between 7 and 9 at night, the facilities are to be used by adults and high school students.

The handsome new building faces Franklin Ave. at Trenton St. The architect was Ronald Greene. It was W. T. Spencer however, who planned most of the details and floor arrangements.
